## Northern Tertiary Challenge – 2006

**Sports:**

Basketball

Netball

Soccer

Touch

Ultimate

Volleyball

Plus still to be confirmed - Daytona and Speed Pool events.

**Cost:**

Total cost to attend this event is \$350.

This includes: Everything necessary for the day include sport and social aspects.

This year after feed back from participants and other students the emphasis has changed to more social sport with no overall shield's presented. However there will be prizes etc.

Team Registration sheets due: Friday 1st September.

Including full team lists with Student ID's.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** All games will start at 9am and run right through the day. NO half day events this year - IE. MORE SPORT!

**Touch:** Rules as per NZ Touch

6 a side with rolling subs

Must have a minimum of 3 females on at any time

6 touches = turnover

Groundball = turnover

Each try = males 1 point, females 2 points.

**Ultimate:**

7 a side with Subs between points only

Must have a minimum of 2 females on at any time, offence match defence with women

Ground Frisbee = turnover

Can't hold Frisbee for longer than 10 seconds (opponent must count out loud)

Can't run or 'step' with Frisbee (as per netball)

Each point scored in opposing in-zone = 5 points

**Netball:**

Mixed Teams

Normal netball rules apply (no stepping, must be 3ft away when defending, held ball = 3 seconds, ball must be touched in each 1/3rd, no contact).

You may only sub players at half time.

Minimum 3 females, plus only 1 male allowed in goal circle at any one time.

**Volleyball:**

6 a side with rolling subs

Minimum of 3 females on at any time

Every point won is a point scored

No touching the net

Maximum of 3 hits then ball must cross the net

**Soccer:**

Mixed soccer competition

Min 3 females on the field at all times

7 a side with rolling subs

Normal Soccer Rules apply.

**Basketball:** (As Basketball NZ rules)

5 a side with rolling subs

Must have minimum of 2 females on at any time

Deliberate contact (elbows, shove etc.) will result in a penalty for the opposition

Females may only be marked by other females

Points will be allocated as follows- Win = 5, Draw = 3, Loss = 1

**RESPECT MUST BE GIVEN TO THE REF AT ALL TIMES:**

If the ref feels at any time that the team/player is acting in an un-sportsmanlike manner, either to opposition or the ref, a penalty/turnover will be awarded to the other team.

At the end of each game, teams must nominate 1 person from opposition team for player of the day award.
