USU (Students' Association at Unitec) is pleased to invite you to the Northern Region Tertiary challenge for 2007.

Venue: Unitec New Zealand, Carrington Rd, Gate 3, Mt Albert, Auckland

Date: 17th August

Registrations due: 10th August 2007

Time: Managers meeting 8.30am. Welcome to all competitors 9am on the sports fields. All Sports start at 9:30am and are held simultaneously, hence competitors may only be able to play one team sport.

Cost: \$20 per participant. USU will invoice you for this when you lodge your registration forms on the 10th August and payment is due by the day of the event.

This includes everything necessary for the games to commence and for the social aspects of the day.

SPORTS BEING PLAYED IN 2007 ARE:

- Netball
- Volleyball
- Basketball
- 7 a side Soccer
- Ultimate Frisbee
- Touch Rugby
- Squash **New Sport**
- Table tennis **New Sport**

There is NO limit to how many teams can enter from each institution in any sport!

Eligibility Criteria:

All students and faculty members of Northern Tertiary Institutions will be eligible to participate at the Northern Tertiary Challenge 2007.

Alcohol: No alcohol is permitted at any of the sporting venues.

Student and Staff ID:

These will be checked before each game and/or randomly throughout the day. Ensure all competitors have their student or faculty ID on them. If a competitor does not have their ID when asked they will not be able to take the court or field and compete.

Touch:

- Mixed Teams
- 6 a side with rolling subs
- Must have a minimum of 2 females on at any time
- 6 touch turn over
- Ground ball = turnover
- Each try – Males = 1 point
Females = 2 points

Netball:

- Mixed teams
- Minimum 1, maximum 3 males on the court at any time, males must be in the 3 separate areas of the court
- Normal netball rules apply
- You may only sub players at half time
- Please supply one set of bibs per team

Basketball:

- Mixed Teams
- 5 a side with rolling subs
- Normal basketball rules apply
- No deliberate contact
- Minimum 2 females on the court at any time

Soccer:

- Mixed teams
- 7 a side with rolling subs
- Minimum of 2 females on at any time
- Normal soccer rules apply
- Goals – Male = 1 goal
Females = 2 goals

Volleyball:

- Mixed teams
- 6 a side with minimum 2 females on at anytime
- Matches will be best of three sets; sets are 15 points
- Every point won is a point scored
- Normal volleyball rules apply

Squash:

- Men's and women's singles
- Normal Squash rules apply
- Best of three sets; each set is to 9 points(or win by 2 points there after)
- No Black soled shoes to be worn
- Please bring your own squash racquet or you will have to pay to hire one

Table Tennis:

- Men and women's singles
- Normal table tennis rules apply
- Best of five sets; each set is to 11 points (first to 11 points, must win by two)
- Please bring your own bats if you can ATTA can supply some but they are not in the best condition.

Ultimate Frisbee:

- Mixed
- 7 a side with subs only after a point is scored
- 2 females on the field at any time
- Ground Frisbee = turn over
- Can not hold Frisbee longer than 5 seconds
- Can not run or step with Frisbee in hand (as per netball rules)
- Three feet away when defending Frisbee carrier
- No contact on Frisbee carrier
- Stall count – defender counts to 10 while attacker holding the frisbee if not released before saying the T in ten then it's a turnover.
- Each point scored = 1 point

Respect must be given to all referees, umpires and officials at all times.

At the end of each game, teams must nominate 1 person from the opposing team for the player of the day award.

Draws will be available after the registration forms have been submitted and prior to the day of the event.
