By signing and submitting this form, you agree now to abide by the full Code of Behaviour for the duration of the NZ University Snow Games 28 August – 3 September 2010.

An original hard-copy of the Code of Behaviour and Registration Form signed with your signature must be physically presented to USNZ

by 5pm Friday 11 August 2010. Present your signed forms to your campus Team Manager prior to the aforementioned date for the successful entry of your Campus' Team forms to USNZ on time. Entries received after 5pm Friday 11 August will incur a late registration fee.

Students attending the USNZ NZ University Snow Games 2010 (herein referred to as 'the Games') do so as representatives of their tertiary institutions, Students' Associations and sports club(s) and are subject to the regulations laid out by those bodies and University Sport New Zealand (USNZ), the latter being the organisers of the Games. For the purposes of this Code of Behaviour attendance at the Games includes; your travel to and from the Games on transport organised by your Students' Association and/or by USNZ; participation in the accreditation process; Opening and Closing Ceremonies, activities in between, including departure day from Wanaka.

First and foremost, participants are attending the Games as **advocates for sport**. All sporting venues, surrounding areas to venues, such as car parks, and any other areas utilised by USNZ for the Games, all transport organised by USNZ or your Students' Association/Club are **alcohol free** and **smoke free**. The utmost consideration must be shown at all times towards venue operators and owners, transport operators and their property, accommodation agencies and their property, billets and Games organisers, members of the general public and other participants attending the Games.

In the unforeseen case where your behaviour discredits your Students' Association, tertiary institution, sports club(s), yourself or the image of students in general, you will be subject to disciplinary action by USNZ or other bodies. Please refer to Section 4 "What behaviour is in breach of this code?" in the USNZ Code of Behaviour online.

Disciplinary action may include:

- A) Exclusion from the Games and all related activities.
- B) Removal from Games transport at any time.
- C) Removal from the team and directed to return home.
- D) Confiscation of your student ID and Games accreditation until your return to your home campus.
- E) Disciplinary action on return to your home campus will be subject to the discretion of your Students' Association Executive and may include:
 - i) Banning you from representing your Students' Association at future USNZ events;
 - ii) Having your Students' Association membership and its privileges revoked;
 - iii) Referral to the disciplinary procedures of your University.

In addition, USNZ has the power to fine you, disqualify you and/or your team from all Games points, and to rule you ineligible for future University sports events and awards, including NZU Blues, selection in University touring teams and future Games competitions.

This Registration Form is only valid if:

- A) This has been signed by the relevant competitor.
- B) All the information has been appropriately completed.
- C) Details have been entered into the Campus Registration Workbook by Campus Team Manager.

Registration Fees including Refund Policy:

- A) All competitors attending the NZ University Snow Games 2010 are required to pay a Registration Fee which will be charged to their Students' Association (or Clubs) at or around the time of the Snow Games. The registration fee covers the basic cost of your attendance at the Games including accreditation, your race bib and the associated social programme events.
- B) Competitors from AUT, Canterbury, Lincoln, Massey Albany, Massey Palmerston North, Massey Wellington, Otago, Victoria and Waikato will be charged a registration fee of \$60.00 (including GST) per competitor to compete in the Games.
- C) Competitors from Auckland University will be charged \$82.50 (including GST) per competitor to compete in the Games.
- D) Competitors from non-universities will be charged \$110.00 (including GST) per competitor to compete in the Games.
- E) Officials (non-competing) are NOT required to pay the registration fee; teams may bring **1 official per 5 competitors**.
- F) Team supporters will be charged the relevant Registration fee to be registered in the Games.
- G) The Registration Fee will NOT be refunded once the USNZ deadline for entries has passed (11 August 2010). Competitors withdrawing from the Games after this deadline has passed will be liable for the Registration Fee.
- H) Competitors will also pay an Event Fee which covers the cost of your participation in the events you have entered.
- I) All Competitors will be charged the following for events entered:

- J) There is no difference between students from different tertiary institutes in the level of the event fee.
- K) In the event of poor weather causing the cancellation of an event, the organisers will attempt to re-schedule the event later in the Games. If the event cannot be re-scheduled then event fees will be refunded to competitors through their Students' Association and/or Club post games – this is **not** an immediate cash refund. If the event is completed successfully at a later stage in the Games then event fees will NOT be refunded.
- L) Competitors may switch between events at no charge providing that the change occurs before 8am on the morning of the event for which they are entered. Changes cannot be made after this deadline.
- M) Competitors withdrawing from events will not receive a refund of their entry fee (assuming the event takes place).
- N) Please note that each Student's Association or Club may add other charges on top of the registration and event fees, which may include items such as team wear, transportation, accommodation etc.
- O) Please note that the Games operates a NO REFUND policy – if your registration is received by USNZ then your Students' Association **WILL** be charged for your attendance at the Games regardless of whether you accredit or not.
- P) Competitors may purchase single day lift passes for \$42.00 including GST per competition day for all competition venues or a 5 day lift pass for \$185 for use of snow fields on specific competition day.
