- Competition:** Thursday 30 March – Sunday 2 April (4 days)
- Match Times:** All Pool matches will start at **10am from Thursday – Saturday.**
Placing matches will start at **9am on Sunday.**
Final will start at **10am on Sunday.**
- The latest a team should arrive is **30 minutes before** the scheduled start time of the respective match!
- Pool A:** Victoria, Canterbury, Massey Albany
Pool B: Massey Palmerston North, Lincoln, AUT
- Cricket Venue:** South Hagley Cricket Oval (South Hagley Park), Christchurch
- Format:** The tournament will be played to standard one day rules – 50 overs per side, with 10 over limit per bowler. See attached USNZ Regulations for the Championship.
- Structure:** The structure of the competition is the 6 participating teams divided into 2 pools, with the winners of each pool meeting in the Final. Other placing matches will also be held on the Sunday. All teams will play 3 matches. Please see the draw.
- Organisation:** The tournament is being arranged by USNZ with assistance from Canterbury Cricket. The Championship Director is Arsel Aslam.
- Squad Size:** A squad can have a maximum of 13 players who cannot be altered or amended once registration has taken place except in exceptional

circumstances and with the agreement of the Championship Director.

- Eligibility:** **A reminder**, to be eligible to compete, all players must either be current enrolled students in 2006 or have been an enrolled student in 2005. All players will be asked to prove either their 2005 or 2006 student status by production of ID cards at accreditation. A player can only represent the University for which he is enrolled.
- NZU Team:** A NZ Universities tournament team will be selected from the Championship and will be announced at the Awards Function on Sunday night.
- Playing Kit:** All teams are required to wear 'white' clothing. This will include white polos and white pants. Teams not complying with the requirements will be asked to do so before stepping onto the field. Please note, coloured piping on the polos will be allowed.
- Umpires:** All matches will have official umpires appointed too.
- Scorers:** All matches will have official scorers appointed too.
- Equipment:** USNZ will provide new match balls for each innings. Stumps will also be provided for all matches.
- Captains' Meeting:** Will be held at the Clubrooms on Saturday 1 April at **6pm** at Hagley Park Oval. All captains will be expected to attend this.
- Awards Function:** Sunday 2 April - 7pm onwards
